

Facilitating digitalisation in the pawnbroking sector

With effect from 1 January 2023



- Under section 63(1) of the Pawnbrokers Act 2015, a notice of forfeiture must be served within two months from the expiry of the redemption period, at the pawnbroker's cost.

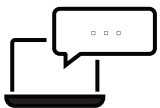

- Pawnbrokers that offer **cashless payment modes**** may impose a fee of up to S\$2 for each pawn ticket issued.
 - ✓ The fee will apply regardless of how the pawner makes payment.
- ** Credit facilities (e.g. credit cards) are excluded.

It will not **apply** if the pawn ticket is issued for:

- ✗ Change of pawner's address, telephone number or email address
- ✗ Change of pawnbroker's name or address
- ✗ Correction of any error on the pawn ticket
